A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE PUBLIC ART ANNUAL PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000-2001

WHEREAS, in February, 1989, the City of Oakland adopted a Public Art Ordinance (Ordinance Number 11066 C.M.S.), authorizing the allocation of 1.5% of municipal capital improvement project costs for the commissioning of public art work, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Ordinance to provide a means for the City to commission artists to create artwork which enlivens, enhances, and enriches the visual environment of the City of Oakland, and

WHEREAS, a Public Art Advisory Committee and Public Art Program staff have developed an Annual Plan for the commissioning of public art projects, and

WHEREAS, the Public Art Annual Plan for FY 2000-2001 was reviewed and accepted by the Cultural Affairs Commission on September 18, 2000, and

WHEREAS, there shall be a preference for Oakland-based artists, and

WHEREAS, the Public Art Plan is designed to place art throughout the city, and includes recommendations to develop programs and projects such as; Adopt-A-Sculpture Program, Broadway Sculpture Row, Oakland Museum Sculpture Court, North Hill Sculpture Project, Redwood Heights/Cal Trans Sculpture Project, Art Partnership Mural Project and a Maintenance and Conservation Program, and to continue the administration of public art projects at the Police Administration Building, Fruitvale Gateway, African American Museum and Library, Jack London Aquatic Center, Coliseum/BART Amtrak Station, Lathan Square/14th and Broadway Transit Center including BART Entrance Re-Design, Broadway/I 880 Underpass, Frank H. Ogawa Plaza Projects including Fountain Sculpture and Plaza Sculpture(s), Pardee Oakland Artist Project, now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that funds are appropriated for public art projects as described in the Public Art Annual Plan for FY 2000-2001 as approved by the Life Enrichment Committee on October 10, 2000.


