RESOLUTION APPROVING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TOP FOUR (4) TRAFFIC SIGNAL LOCATIONS AND THE TOP TWO (2) PEDESTRIAN SIGNAL LOCATIONS CITYWIDE, PURSUANT TO CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 78747 C.M.S.

WHEREAS, the residents and the general public request traffic and pedestrian signals at many intersections citywide; and

WHEREAS, staff periodically evaluates requests for traffic and pedestrian signals and assigns points according to the City's signal warrant and priority system pursuant to the City Council Resolution No. 78747 C.M.S., as well as a ten-year pedestrian accident history; and

WHEREAS, over 300 intersections exist on the signal need priority list; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Community and Economic Development Agency, Transportation Services Division, is directed to implement the top four traffic signal locations:

- Seminary Avenue at Avenal Avenue
- International Boulevard at 50th Avenue
- Fruitvale Avenue at School Street
- Foothill Boulevard at 34th Avenue

and the top two pedestrian signal locations:

- International Boulevard at 36th Avenue
- High Street at Porter Street

as budgeted in the adopted 2007-2009 policy budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That staff shall continue to periodically evaluate intersections and present to the City Council a prioritized list of locations identified for traffic or pedestrian signals for funding and implementation.


