A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND 1 PM 3: 01, APPROPRIATE A GRANT FOR \$76,870 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA), UNITED STATES FIRE ADMINISTRATION (USFA), TO THE OAKLAND FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING THAT WILL INCREASE CAPABILITIES TO RESPOND TO TERRORIST-RELATED CHEMICAL, BIOLOGICAL, RADIOLOGICAL, NUCLEAR AND EXPLOSIVES (CBRNE) INCIDENTS AND OTHER HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INCIDENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland and the City Council are committed to proactive emergency preparedness, mitigation and response; and,

WHEREAS, the Oakland Fire Department developed a grant proposal for the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), United States Fire Administration (USFA), requesting \$76,870, to assisting in purchasing specialized equipment and training to prepare for and respond to terrorist related chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosives (CBRNE) incidents and other hazardous materials incidents; and,

WHEREAS, the USFA accepted and approved the grant proposal submitted by the Oakland Fire Department; and,

WHEREAS, the USFA awarded the Oakland Fire Department \$76,870 for specialized equipment and training; and

WHEREAS, the applicant's matching share must be in the form of cash; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has identified sufficient funds in Fund 1010, Organization 20816, Account 52914, to satisfy the \$32,943 required match; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That, the City Council hereby authorizes the CityAdministrator to accept and appropriate a grant for seventy six thousand eight hundred and seventy dollars (\$76,870) from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), United States Fire Administration (USFA), to the Oakland Fire Department, in Fund 2124, the Emergency Response Support Program, PS26, Organization Number 20816, for specialized equipment and training to prepare for and respond to terrorist-related CBRNE incidents and other hazardous materials incidents and that the grant revenues collected will be equivalent to the USFA grant award.
