RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF \$11,100 FROM COUNCILMEMBER ~~SCHAAF'S~~ CAMPBELL WASHINGTON'S GRAFFITI ABATEMENT MURAL AND GREEN WALL FUNDS TO ROCK PAPER SCISSORS COLLECTIVE FOR A MURAL ON THE WALL OF THE FAIRFAX LIGHTHOUSE DELIVERANCE CENTER AT 5345 FOOTHILL BLVD, OAKLAND

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2013, the City Council adopted a budget that set aside Graffiti abatement funds for Murals and Green Walls in the amount of \$50,000 for each council member to address graffiti within their districts; and

WHEREAS, the wall on the Fairfax Lighthouse Community Church is currently in a state of graffiti blight; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember ~~SchAAF~~ Campbell Washington wishes to grant a portion of her Graffiti Abatement Mural and Green Wall Funds to Rock Paper Scissors Collective for a mural on the Fairfax Lighthouse Deliverance Center building to beautify this culturally rich neighborhood, as well as to abate and deter graffiti; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with City requirements Rock Paper Scissors Collective will provide documentation for the use of the Councilmember's Graffiti Abatement Mural and Green Wall funds and for use of the proposed mural site; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the use of \$11,100 from Councilmember ~~Libby SchAAF's~~ Annie Campbell Washington's Graffiti Abatement Mural and Green Wall funds for a grant to Rock Paper Scissors Collective for a mural on the Fairfax Lighthouse Deliverance Center building at 5345 Foothill Blvd. in Oakland; and be it


