INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO 1) ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE AN ADDITIONAL \$13,345 FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 14 FUNDS FOR A TOTAL GRANT AMOUNT OF \$6,513,345; AND 2) TO SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH AMEND THE PROFESSIONAL GROUP 4 ARCHITECTURE RESEARCH AND PLANNING, INC. TO PROVIDE FULL DESIGN AND ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE NEW 81ST AVENUE COMMUNITY LIBRARY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,600,000, AND TO COMPLETE THE MASTER FACILITIES PLAN TO INCLUDE DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIES FOR THE MAIN PUBLIC LIBRARY AND FOR CONTINUED COMMUNITY OUTREACH SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$225,000, FOR A TOTAL AMENDED CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,325,000

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland and the Oakland Public Library submitted a Proposition 14 grant application and received \$6,513,345 from the State of California to assist in the construction of the new 28,000 square foot co-located public library with the Oakland Unified School District known as the 81st Avenue Community Library; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland and the Oakland Public Library wishes to accept and appropriate the additional funding of \$13,345 over the amount (\$6.5 million) previously accepted and appropriated by the City Council under Resolution 78185 C.M.S. in November 2003; and

WHEREAS, local match funding of \$3.50 million has been identified as part of the setaside of the Oakland Redevelopment Agency's Coliseum tax increment funds available and appropriated for this project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland and the Oakland Unified School District are committed to developing cooperative relationships that further the quality of life for the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland, the Oakland Public Library and the Oakland Unified School District have developed a Joint Use Agreement that defines the benefits and costs to the Library and the School District; and

WHEREAS, the co-located library, to be sited on land provided by the Oakland Unified School District, holds tremendous potential for benefits to the children and underserved residents of this neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Unified School District has committed approximately \$1,745 million toward its portion of the co-located library; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Public Library has embarked on the development of a longrange Master Facilities Planning process that includes the development of Community and Neighborhood Libraries providing a wide range of services and collections; and

WHEREAS, the success of the Proposition 14 grant application was heavily dependent on the work of the long range master planning developed in the Draft Master Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, Group 4's substantial experience and expertise in library master planning and design were responsible for the successful Proposition 14 grant application for the 81st Ave Community Library; and

WHEREAS, the original agreement authorized the consultant to perform all work in future phases, which included providing full design, engineering and construction support services in the event that the Proposition 14 application was successful; and

WHEREAS, this contract amendment is not subject to the competitive RFP process because the scope of services identified in the Request For Proposals and the original agreement was intended to encompass work in all phases; and

WHEREAS, this contract amendment is necessary to proceed with the design, engineering, and construction of the 81st Ave Community Library funded by the Proposition 14 grant; and

WHEREAS, this contract amendment is also necessary to complete the Master Facilities Plan in order that the Main Library and other branch facilities would be prime, eligible, and competitive for prospective applications in the event of a future state bond measure; and

WHEREAS, Group 4 will meet the City and Redevelopment Agency's 20% Local Business Enterprise Program requirement (LBE/SLBE), the Equal Benefits Ordinance (EBO), and the Living Wage Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this agreement amendment is for services of a professional, scientific or technical nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that services under this contract will be temporary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is authorized to accept and appropriate an additional \$13,345 from the State of California Proposition 14 funds for a total grant acceptance amount of six million, five hundred and thirteen thousand, three hundred and forty-five dollars (\$6,513,345); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is authorized to amend the existing professional services agreement of \$500,000 with Group 4 Architectural Research and Planning, Inc. to provide full design, engineering and construction support services for new the 81st Avenue Community Library in the amount of one million, six hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is authorized to amend the existing professional services agreement with Group 4 in the amount of two hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) to complete the Master Facilities Plan to include development strategies for the Main Public Library and for continued community outreach services for a total contract amount not to exceed two million, three hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$2,325,000); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of the agreement will be on file in the City Clerk's Office and will be approved for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney.
