

RESOLUTION NO. 79975 C. M. S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$78,462 FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY CALIFORNIA LIBRARY LITERACY SERVICE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006-2007 TO SUPPORT THE OAKLAND PUBLIC LIBRARY SECOND START ADULT LITERACY PROGRAM

WHEREAS: The California State Library has made available California Library Literacy Service (CLLS) program funds in a matching grant program for public library literacy programs in fiscal year 2006-2007; and

WHEREAS: The City of Oakland desires to apply for and accept a grant in the amount of seventy-eight thousand four hundred sixty-two (\$78,462) dollars from the California State Library California Library Literacy Service to support the Oakland Public Library's Second Start Adult Literacy Program; and

WHEREAS: This grant was included in the FY 2005-07 Adopted Policy Budget and \$78,462 has been appropriated to California Library Services Fund (2148), Literacy Organization (61213), Unassigned Projects; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized and directed to apply for and accept a CLLS grant in the amount of seventy-eight thousand four hundred sixty-two dollars (\$78,462) to be deposited in California Library Services Fund (2148), Literacy Organization (61213), CLSA Matching Fund Project (G250210) for the purpose described above to fund four part-time positions (two Literacy Assistants, one Office Assistant I, and one Office Assistant II); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator or her designee as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations, applications, agreements, payment requests, and related actions which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project in accordance with its basic purpose; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That should additional funds be received, the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to appropriate same for the purposes described above without returning to Council.
