SUBJECT: REQUEST TO SCHEDULE AGENDA ITEM

TITLE: Resolution Authorizing the City of Oakland to Apply for, Accept, and Appropriate up to \$1,357,000 in FY 04-05 Transportation Fund, for Clean Air Funds for the Following Four Projects: 1) Oakland Airport – Coliseum Area Intelligent Transportation System Deployment – Phase I (\$800,000); 2) Market Street Regional Bikeway (\$400,000); 3) Clay Street Garage Central Cashiering System (\$97,000); and 4) Bicycle Parking Request Program (\$60,000)

Is there a statutory, regulatory, financial or grant deadline? Specify:

Is a staff report required/requested? Yes. Oakland's Council Resolution will be due to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District by July 31, 2004.

What is the fiscal impact on the City/Agency? Matching funds of 20% are required for TFCA grant requests over \$100,000. A match of \$200,000 for the Oakland Airport – Coliseum Area Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Deployment – Phase I will be provided through City Measure B Funds. \$113,000 for the Market Street Regional Bikeway match will be provided by City resurfacing funds. \$20,000 in Measure B Funds is earmarked for bicycle parking maintenance to supplement the Bicycle Parking Request grant. No match is provided or required for the Clay Street Central Cashiering System.
