RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$90,000 IN TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX SURCHARGE FUNDS TO FULFILL CULTURAL SERVICES GRANTS TO THIRTY-NINE (39) OAKLAND-BASED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND INDIVIDUAL ARTISTS PROVIDING ARTS AND CULTURAL SERVICES IN OAKLAND DURING FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 AND TO ENTER INTO A CULTURAL SERVICES GRANT AGREMENT WITH AFRICAN QUEENS YOUTH PERFORMANCE COMPANY FOR ARTS AND CULTURAL SERVICES IN OAKLAND DURING FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010

WHEREAS, in 1985, the City Council adopted the first arts funding policies and procedures for the City of Oakland, establishing a panel system of evaluating funding proposals and distributing City funds to the arts; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Funding Program within the Cultural Arts and Marketing Division of the CEDA is the City's funding mechanism to support Oakland-based nonprofit organizations and artists providing arts and cultural activities to the public; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Cultural Funding Program is to fund Oakland-based art and cultural activities that reflect the diversity of the city for citizens of and visitors to Oakland, focusing on the key areas of General Support, Neighborhood Arts and Arts Education; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 82288 C.M.S. approved by the City Council authorized cultural services grants to 70 Oakland-based nonprofit organizations and individual artists providing arts and cultural services in Oakland during fiscal year 2009-2010; and

WHEREAS, the majority of funding for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Cultural Funding Program grant contracts, in the amount of \$974,647, was budgeted in the FY 2009-2010 budget within the General Purpose Fund; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 82305 C.M.S. approved by the City Council appropriated estimated proceeds in the amount of \$114,484 from the Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) surcharge to the Cultural Arts and Marketing Division of the Community and Economic Development Agency (CEDA) in order to supplement the reduced General Purpose Fund appropriation and fulfill the awards for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 grant contracts; and

WHEREAS, the actual Fiscal Year 2009-2010 proceeds available for this purpose within the TOT fund account 1.2419.88742.41515.P391850.CE02 for the Cultural Arts & Marketing Division's Cultural Funding Program total \$90,000; and

WHEREAS, TOT funding allocations for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Cultural Funding Program grants contracts will be distributed as follows:
