A RESOLUTION CELEBRATING THE WEEK OF MAY 18 THROUGH MAY 24, 2008, AS NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND

WHEREAS, the Public Works Agency provides services that are an integral part of our residents' everyday lives; hence, the health, safety and comfort of this great city depends on the efficient and reliable operations of sewers, streets, storm drains, public facilities, and parks; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Agency is committed to improving its relationships, customer service, image, and developing stronger community linkages; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Agency earned an accreditation from the American Public Works Association on August 15, 2006, becoming only the 3rd Public Works Agency in California, and 35th in North America to receive such certification; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Agency received the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's 2007 Clean Water Act Recognition Award; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Agency was the winner of the 2008 American Public Works Northern California Project of the Year for the Disaster or Emergency Construction/Repair of the Oakland Maze I-580 freeway overpass collapse; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Agency was the winner of the 2008 American Public Works Northern California Project of the Year for the Disaster or Emergency Construction/Repair of the McKillop Emergency Roadway Restoration; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Agency is launching "Cityworks," a new work management system that will enable the Agency to take a quantum leap into 21st century technology and help optimize our service response; and

WHEREAS, May 18 through May 24, 2008, the American Public Works Association celebrates National Public Works Week throughout the country and this year's national theme is "The Future Is Now;" now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council does hereby proclaim the week of May 18, 2008, as National Public Works Week in the City of Oakland and urges all citizens to recognize and commend the Public Works Agency for its important work and accomplishments.
