RE: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO RAY'S

ELECTRIC FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF BULBOUTS ON GRAND AVENUE (PROJECT NUMBER G170430) IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$335,930)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared for Council approval that authorizes the award of a construction contract to Ray's Electric for the Construction of Bulbouts on Grand Avenue (Project No. G170430) in the amount of \$335,930.

Ray's Electric is the lowest responsible bidder and has met the project's goals. Funds are available for this contract.

This project is consistent with the Mayor and City Council Goal to Maintain and Enhance Oakland's Physical Assets. The project is located in Council District 2.

It is recommended that the resolution be approved.

FISCAL IMPACT

The construction contract will be in the amount **of** \$335,930. Funding for this contract is available in the Capital Improvements fund (5500); Organization 92242; Construction Contract Account 57411; Project G170430. There are sufficient funds available in the project budget for the work.

BACKGROUND

The proposed work consists of the construction of bulbouts and street medians, which, in general, includes structural excavation and backfill, sidewalk, curb and gutter, drainage, street medians, traffic signal modification, asphalt concrete and traffic control work along Grand Avenue (between Elwood Avenue and Lakeshore Avenue) and along Lake Park Avenue (between Grand Avenue and Lake Park Way).

On August 25,2003, the City Clerk received the following bid for the project:

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project is 50%, which consists of 15% LBE and 35% SLBE.

There will be LBE/SLBE participation of \$280,876 (83.61%), which exceeds the City's goal of 50%. There will also be \$3,600 (100%) local trucking participation for this project. The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of new hires to be Oakland residents. The LBE/SLBE information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Manager's Office and is shown on *Attachment B*.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Construction work is scheduled to begin in December 2003 and will be completed by February 2004. The contract specifies \$500 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract completion time of 35 working days is exceeded. The project schedule is also shown on *Attachment A*,

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

The construction of sidewalk, bulbouts, and wheelchair ramps will improve air quality to the extent that pedestrian traffic is encouraged. Improvements to the aesthetics and pedestrian facilities will aid in making walking a more attractive mode of transportation, thereby encouraging reduction in automobile usage and reducing vehicle emissions.

In addition, the contractor will utilize recyclable materials within the concrete and asphalt concrete construction materials to the extent possible.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

This project includes accessibility improvements. The construction of sidewalk, bulbouts, and wheelchair ramps will improve access to City streets and sidewalks for senior citizens, persons with disabilities and all pedestrians in general. Curb ramps will be constructed to current state and federal standards.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends that the City Council approve a resolution authorizing the award of the construction contract to Ray's Electric for the Construction of Bulbouts on Grand Avenue (Project No. G170430) in the amount of \$335,930. Ray's Electric has met the LBE/SLBE and local trucking goals, and there are sufficient funds in the project account.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staffrecommends that the City Council approve the resolution.



WHEREAS, Ray's Electric is the lowest responsible bidder for the project and has met the LBE/SLBE requirements; and

WHEREAS, the construction contract will be in the amount of \$335,930 and funding is available in the Capital Improvements fund (5500); and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the contract for the Construction of Bulbouts on Grand Avenue (Project Number G170430) is hereby awarded to Ray's Electric, in accordance with the terms of its bid therefore, dated August 25,2003, for the amount of Three Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$335,930); and be it
