Dale Gieringer has been the state coordinator of California NORML (National Organization for the Reform of Marijuana Laws) since 1987. In this capacity he has spoken with thousands of medical marijuana users and is the author of "Marijuana Medical Handbook." He is Vice-Chairman of the national NORML board of directors. He is also director of the California Drug Policy Forum (DPFCA) and treasurer of the Oakland Civil Liberties Alliance (OCLA). He has published research on medical marijuana usage, marijuana smoke harm reduction, potency testing, marijuana and driving safety, and drug urinalysis. He has testified before the legislature and in court on issues concerning personal use of marijuana. He was one of the original co-authors of California's medical marijuana initiative, Prop. 215, the proponent of Oakland's Measure Z cannabis initiative in 2004, and a sponsor of California's pathbreaking legalization bill, AB 390.

Richard Lee has been working to end cannabis prohibition for 17 years. In 1992 he co-founded Legal Marijuana - The Hemp Store in Houston, Texas, one of the first hemp products retail outlets in the United States. Lee moved to Oakland in 1997 and co-founded the Hemp Research Company, supplying cannabis to the Oakland Cannabis Buyers' Club and researching efficient and environmentally friendly cannabis horticulture.

In 1999, he opened the Bulldog Coffeeshop, the second cannabis outlet in "Oaksterdam". In 2003 Lee founded the Oakland Civil Liberties Alliance, the PAC that passed Oakland's Measure Z making private sales, cultivation, and possession of cannabis the lowest law enforcement priority and mandating that Oakland tax and regulate cannabis as soon as possible under state law.

From 2005 to 2007, Lee published the Oaksterdam News quarterly newspaper with a circulation of over 100,000. In 2007, he founded the first cannabis college in the United States, Oaksterdam University. In 2008 he funded the startup of the monthly magazine West Coast Cannabis, current circulation 30,000.

Since 2005, Lee has been serving on the City of Oakland Cannabis Regulation and Revenue Ordinance Commission, which was created after Measure Z passed with 65% of the vote 2004.

He manages several other Oaksterdam companies, including the Oaksterdam Gift Shop and Nursery. His dedication to ending cannabis prohibition continues to play a crucial role in the revitalization and economic growth of Oakland.

RESOLUTION RE-APPOINTING JAMES ANTHONY, LESLIE BONETT, DALE GIERINGER, RICHARD LEE, KEITH STEPHENSON, AND JOSEPH VILLATORO, AND APPOINTING TC EVERETT AS MEMBERS OF THE MEASURE Z COMMUNITY OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE, TO 'OVERSEE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE OAKLAND CANNABIS REGULATION AND REVENUE ORDINANCE'

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2004, the voters of the City of Oakland enacted the Oakland Cannabis Regulation and Revenue Ordinance, a voter initiative commonly referred to as Measure Z; and

WHEREAS, Measure Z makes the investigation, citation and arrest for private adult cannabis (marijuana) offenses (e.g. use distribution, sale, cultivation and possession of cannabis for medical and non-medical purposes) the City of Oakland's lowest law enforcement priority; and

WHEREAS, Measure Z also created an eleven member, advisory Community Oversight Committee (Ordinance No. 12694 C.M.S.), appointed to two year terms commencing with the first day of August 2005, to oversee the ordinance's implementation and provided that the committee shall include one community member appointed by each City Councilmember, one community member appointed by the Mayor, one representative appointed by the Oakland City Auditor and one representative appointed by the City Administrator, and

WHEREAS, the above referenced ordinance was amended by Ordinance No. 12958 C.M.S., on July 21, 2009 to stagger the appointment term of members, odd numbered Council Districts, Mayor, and City Administrator appointments shall be made in odd numbered years and even numbered City Council Districts, the At Large and City Auditor appointments shall be made in even years, and

WHEREAS, for the year beginning the first day of August 2009 only, members appointed by Councilmembers in Districts 2, 4, 6, At Large, and the representative from the City Auditor shall be appointed to a one (1) year term, providing they do not vacate their position or are not reappointed by their appointing authority; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That by the nomination of the Mayor, the following individuals are hereby appointed to the terms set forth below:

Measure Z Community Oversight Committee

James Anthony, District 4 nominee, Mayoral appointment to serve the term beginning August 1, 2009 and ending July 31, 2010, filling the seat he currently holds.

Leslie Bonett, Mayor nominee, Mayoral appointment to serve the term beginning August 1, 2009 and ending July 31, 2011, filling the seat she currently holds.

TC Everett, At Large nominee, Mayoral appointment to serve the term beginning August 1, 2009 and ending July 31, 2010, filling the seat previously held by Frank Rose.

Dale Gieringer, District 1 nominee, Mayoral appointment to serve the term beginning August 1, 2009 and ending July 31, 2011, filling the seat he currently holds.

Richard Lee, District 3 nominee, Mayoral appointment to serve the term beginning August 1, 2009 and ending July 31, 2011, filling the seat he currently holds.

Keith Stephenson, District 7 nominee, Mayoral appointment to serve the term beginning August 1, 2009 and ending July 31, 2011, filling the seat he currently holds.

Joseph Villatoro, District 2 nominee, Mayoral appointment to serve the term beginning August 1, 2009 and ending July 31, 2010, filling the seat he currently holds.
