**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Administrator, or her designee, to enter into professional services contracts in an amount not-to-exceed seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) each with 1) Applied Materials & Engineering, Inc., 2) Biggs Cardosa Associates, Inc., 3) Consolidated Engineering Laboratories, 4) Construction Testing Services, Inc., 5) Ninyo & Moore, and 6) URS for on-call special inspection and testing services over a period of three years.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

On-call special inspection and testing services are required to provide quality assurance, quality control, and various laboratory and sampling services necessary to support and facilitate the City of Oakland's Capital Improvement Program. Services required may include specialized inspection, welding and anchor bolt inspection, materials field sampling, structural and laboratory testing, and plant/factory inspection. Typical types of projects that may require these services include bridges, retaining walls, structures, recreation centers, libraries, public safety buildings, administration buildings, roadways, paving, sidewalks, traffic signals, underground pipelines, and various other capital improvement projects.

**OUTCOME**

Approval of the proposed resolution will award professional service contracts to various firms to provide on-call special inspection and testing services to support the City's capital improvement program.

## **BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

The Public Works Agency (PWA) manages a wide variety of capital improvement projects. To deliver these projects in a timely and cost effective manner, PWA utilizes professional services contracts solicited through a competitive process in accordance to OMC section 2.04.051. It is anticipated that many capital improvement projects will need to utilize these special inspection and testing services throughout the three year duration of the proposed contracts. These on-call contracts will allow the City to promptly provide the necessary qualified and certified inspectional and laboratory testing services to meet, maintain, and document quality control on capital projects. Use of on-call contracts will reduce the time and processes associated with selecting firms on an individual project-by-project basis and thereby provide cost savings to the City.

In April 2013, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for On-Call Special Inspection and Testing Services. Seven (7) firms responded to the RFQ. PWA staff evaluated each RFQ submittal for compliance with the minimum requirements, and to verify the experience and qualifications of staff, and certifications of equipment and facilities.

## **ANALYSIS**

All seven (7) firms who responded to the RFQ have the necessary technical expertise, and all have the required experience and certifications. However one firm, ISI Inspection Services, Inc. (Berkeley), did not meet the Local/Small Local Business Enterprise requirements. ISI Inspectional Services, Inc. had a proposed 0% local/small local level of participation. All other six (6) responding firms are certified local business enterprises and exceeded the City's Local/Small Local Business Enterprise (L/SLBE) program requirements. Each firm is also compliant to the Equal Benefits Ordinance (EBO). The Contracts and Compliance Unit has verified the L/SLBE information for each firm (see *Attachment A*).

## **PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST**

The City's web-based procurement system iSupplier was utilized for distribution of the RFQ. The RFQ was also formally advertised on two occasions in one newspaper: The Oakland Tribune.

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**COST SUMMARY/IMPLICATIONS**

Each contract will be for an amount not-to-exceed seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000). The on-call special inspection and testing services will be utilized for projects funded by various capital improvement funds, bonds, and grants such as Measure DD, Measure WW, Measure B, Trade Corridor Improvement funds, Community Development Block Grants, State Department of Parks and Recreation grants, and others. The approval of these contracts will not result in additional appropriation of funds. The services will be funded through the appropriations of individual projects which will be identified prior to the performance of the work.

**SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES**

**Economic:** The contracts will generate business tax, sales tax, and other revenues for the City by those firms who work on the project. Local businesses will be utilized on the projects and will benefit directly.

**Environmental:** Environmental factors and opportunities will be considered and incorporated to the extent feasible. Consultants will be required to consider the integration of environmental, waste reduction, and energy conversation opportunities.


**Social Equity:** The proposed services will provide for higher quality control and quality assurance in the implementation of capital improvement projects for public use.

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO A SERIES OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$750,000.00) EACH WITH THE FIRMS OF 1) APPLIED MATERIALS & ENGINEERING, INC. (LBE), 2) BIGGS CARDOSA ASSOCIATES, INC. (LBE), 3) CONSOLIDATED ENGINEERING LABORATORIES (LBE), 4) CONSTRUCTION TESTING SERVICES, INC. (LBE), 5) NINYO & MOORE (LBE), AND 6) URS (LBE) FOR ON-CALL SPECIAL INSPECTION AND TESTING SERVICES OVER A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS**

**WHEREAS**, special inspection & testing services are required to construct projects that involve bridges, retaining walls, structures, recreation centers, libraries, public safety buildings, administration buildings, roadways, paving, sidewalks, traffic signals, underground pipelines, and various other capital improvement projects; and

**WHEREAS**, on-call special inspection & testing services contracts allow the City to promptly respond and provide the necessary services in an efficient and timely manner; and

**WHEREAS**, unscheduled construction projects will occur throughout the three-year contract period and will likely require on-call special inspection & testing services; and

**WHEREAS**, the special inspection & testing services will be funded through the various individual projects and funds will be identified prior to the performance of the services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City conducted a competitive Request for Qualifications (RFQ) selection process; and

**WHEREAS**, seven (7) firms responded to the City's RFQ process and six (6) of these firms were deemed technically qualified and in full compliance with the City's Local/Small Local Enterprise program requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to enter into a contract with the six (6) firms that were deemed technically qualified and who met the City's L/SLBE program requirements for professional services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the professional special inspection and testing services are exempt from competitive bidding pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code Section 2.04.051A; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that the special inspection & testing services under contract are temporary in nature; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into professional service contracts in an amount not to exceed seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000.00) each with 1) Applied Materials & Engineering, Inc., 2) Biggs Cardosa Associates, Inc., 3) Consolidated Engineering Laboratories, 4) Construction Testing Services, Inc., 5) Ninyo & Moore, and 6) URS for on-call special inspection & testing services; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That for any work issued under this resolution requiring the use of any City General Purpose Fund money not already specifically appropriated by City Council to the project, the City Administrator shall return to the City Council for approval of the allocation of the General Purpose Fund money; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the contract term will be for three (3) years from the date of the contract execution; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to approve subsequent amendments to or extensions of said contract with the exception of those related to an increase in total compensation or the allocation of additional funds, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be filed with the City Clerk's Office, and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That a copy of the contract will be on file in the City Clerk's Office and will be approved for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney.
