RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$29,973) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR CONTINUATION OF THE GANG RESISTANCE EDUCATION AND TRAINING (GREAT) PROGRAM AT COLE MIDDLE SCHOOL

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds in the amount of \$29,973 will be awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, for continued instruction of the Gang Resistance Education and Training (GREAT) program by the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, these federal grant funds are earmarked to provide gang resistance education to 6th and 7th grade students enrolled at Cole Middle School; and

WHEREAS, funding for the GREAT program will assist in the Police Department's goal of decreasing incidents of youth-based violence and other delinquent activities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 78895 C.M.S. dated November 16, 2004, Resolution No. 77698 C.M.S. dated March 18, 2003, and Resolution No. 77013 C.M.S. dated March 12, 2002; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept \$29,973 in grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs and to increase revenues and appropriate said budget to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That grant funds shall be maintained in the Federal Grant Fund: 2112; Campus Life And School Safety (CLASS) Org.: 105530; Youth and Community Services Program PS04; in a Project Number to be established; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award.
