WHEREAS, the Phoenix Awards Institute, Inc., in collaboration with the EPA, celebrated this environmental and community development achievement by awarding the prestigious "Phoenix Award;" now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, the City Council of the City of Oakland hereby commends East Bay Habitat for Humanity, the Environmental Services Division of the Oakland Public Works Agency, and the Housing Development Division of the Community and Economic Development Agency for earning the prestigious 2004 Phoenix Award by successfully developing a "brownfield" site and revitalizing an Oakland neighborhood.
