INTRODUCED BY VICE-MAYOR IGNACIO DE LA FUENTE

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ASSEMBLY BILL 772 (AMMIANO) "LOCAL GOVERNMENT IDENTIFICATION ACT," WHICH WOULD AUTHORIZE COUNTIES TO ESTABLISH MUNICIPAL ID PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, many people in Oakland limited to immigrants, children and st disabled and elderly, runaway youth a and others—currently suffer from the la their access to law enforcement, financ and workplace protections; and

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WHEREAS, many marginalized commu and without identification are afraid to re

WHEREAS, those who lack a valid form report labor and housing violations—suc and workplace health, safety, and wage v authorities; and

WHEREAS, without appropriate identifica , it is difficult to open bank accounts, and immigrants carrying large amounts of cash are therefore specifically targeted for robbery and other violent crimes; and

WHEREAS, lack of a valid form of identification translates into limited access to financial institutions and fear of police and other city officials, thus resulting in decreased participation in the formal city economy and other civic matters; and

WHEREAS, AB 772 will make it easier for all Californian's to participate in local and regional commerce—by opening a bank account, establishing credit, and accessing loans and the housing market; and

WHEREAS, AB 772 will fill a void by providing an official form of personal identification for the many residents who currently lack one; and

WHEREAS, AB 772 will facilitate participation in civic activities; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland City Council will be considering the implementation its own municipal ID ordinance on May 26th; and

WHEREAS, Oakland supports efforts such as those of AB 772 which help create a reliable form of identification for all residents; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: The City of Oakland declares its support for AB 772 (Ammiano); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby directs the City Administrator and the City's legislative lobbyist to advocate for the above position in the California State Legislature.
