INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER REBECCA KAPLAN

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF \$20,000 FROM COUNCILMEMBER KAPLAN'S ANTI-GRAFFITI MURAL FUNDS TO ATTITUDINAL HEALING CONNECTION FOR THE THIRD MURAL IN THEIR SUPER HEROS PROJECT ON THE FREEWAY UNDERPASS ON WEST STREET, BETWEEN 35TH ST. AND 36TH STREET .

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2013, the City Council adopted a budget that set aside Anti Graffiti funds for Murals and Greenwalls for council members to grant to address graffiti within their districts;

WHEREAS, any expenditures for purposes other than City or other governmental infrastructure, furniture, or equipment require council approval; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Rebecca Kaplan wishes to grant a portion of her Anti Graffiti funds to Attitudinal Healing Connection for the development and implementation of their Super Heros project on the freeway underpass on West Street, between 35th and 36th Street ; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with City requirements, Anti Graffiti funds to Attitudinal Healing Connection will provide documentation for the use of the Councilmember's Anti Graffiti funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council authorizes the grant of \$20,000.00 from Councilmember Rebecca Kaplan's Anti- Graffiti funds to the Anti Graffiti funds to Attitudinal Healing Connection for the development and implementation of a mural; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator is authorized to execute an appropriate grant agreement with Anti Graffiti funds to Attitudinal Healing Connection for the above purpose, subject to approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
