RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That City Council Adopt A Resolution Approving Ongoing Cooperative Agreements Exceeding \$250,000 For Commodities And Service Contracts For Public Works Department's Internal Services (Fleet Services and Facility Maintenance) As Set Forth In Table 1 In Accordance With City Council Budget Appropriations And Allocations As Adopted By The Fiscal Year 2023-25 Budget.

REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL

At the July 11, 2023 Public Works and Transportation Committee meeting, members of the Committee requested information regarding the total number of cooperative agreements on the attached list that were with Oakland vendors.

This supplemental report identifies 19 Oakland vendors that have current cooperative agreements for commodities, goods and services with the Bureau of Maintenance and Internal Services (BMIS). The 19 cooperative agreements are valued at \$13,500,000 for commodities and services to be acquired from the City of Oakland. In addition, local contractor participation in the cooperative agreement process, extends their business beyond Oakland boarders and further stimulates our local economy.

In reviewing the list of 98 cooperative agreements on the original report it was determined that several critical cooperative agreements were omitted. This was found to be due to a sorting error and is corrected in this supplemental report and *Attachment A*.

The correct number of established cooperative agreements exceeding \$250,000 is 98, with a total contract capacity of \$90,700,000 million.
