**A Resolution Commending Steven M. Schwartzberg
For 32 years of dedicated service to the residents of Oakland and

WHEREAS, Steven M. Schwartzberg has served as Director of the Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program since 1992; and

WHEREAS, Steven M. Schwartzberg has provided 32 years of dedicated service to the residents of Oakland and all of Alameda County in various administrative capacities with the Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program, the Department of Psychiatry at Highland General Hospital, and the Alameda County Public Health Department; and

WHEREAS, under his leadership, the Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program has provided educational and prevention services to Oakland residents regarding the hazards of lead poisoning and encouraged all parents and caregivers to ensure that all children under the age of six years receive a blood lead test to identify and treat lead poisoned children; and

WHEREAS, during Mr. Schwartzberg's tenure, the Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program provided lead remediation for 796 units of low-income housing in the City of Oakland, thereby ensuring lead-safe homes for children and families; and

WHEREAS, under his leadership, the Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program has received national acclaim for its role in lead poisoning prevention and as pioneer in the development of the Healthy Homes concept and strategies to address other environmental and safety hazards in the home; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That Steven M. Schwartzberg has devoted his more than 30 years of his life to the betterment of the health and well being of the residents of Oakland, and in particular the children; and be it
