**RESOLUTION AMENDING CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 88654 C.M.S. TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF GRANT AGREEMENTS WITH EXISTING VIOLENCE INTERVENTION PROGRAM SERVICE PROVIDERS AND TO AWARD A NEW GRANT AGREEMENT TO PROGRESSIVE TRANSITIONS INC. FOR THE PROVISION VIOLENCE INTERVENTION SERVICES FOR A TOTAL GRANT AMOUNT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 NOT TO EXCEED NINE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$9,815,000)**

**WHEREAS**, on May 18, 2021 City Council authorized renewal of grant agreements with the existing violence prevention service providers for a total amount not to exceed \$8,560,000 for a third one-year term beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, for the purpose of funding violence intervention services to high-risk youth and young adults (Resolution No. 88654 C.M.S.); and

**WHEREAS**, on June 24, 2021, City Council adopted the Biennial Budget for Fiscal Years 2021-23 (Resolution No. 88717 C.M.S.), which allocated general purpose funds to the Department of Violence Prevention in the amount of \$7,000,000 in Fiscal Year 2021-22 to address the dramatic uptick in community and gender-based violence during the pandemic as part of the City's efforts to Reimagine Public Safety; and

**WHEREAS**, DVP recommends increasing the amount of grant agreements with several existing violence prevention service providers in a total amount not to exceed \$1,155,000 for Fiscal Year 2021-22, for the purpose of funding violence intervention services to high-risk youth and young adults detailed herein; and

**WHEREAS**, DVP recommends awarding a new grant agreement to Progressive Transitions Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for the provision of violence intervention services; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby amends Resolution No. 88654 C.M.S. to increase the amount of the grant agreements with the violence intervention service providers identified below in the amounts specified therein and to award a new grant agreement to Progressive Transitions Inc. for Fiscal Year 2021-22:


