(2) A Redevelopment Agency Resolution Authorizing A Contribution Of An Amount Not-To-Exceed Four Hundred Eight Thousand Six Hundred Seven Dollars (\$408,607) From The Central District Redevelopment Project To The City Of Oakland Under The Cooperation Agreement To Fund The Construction Of the Broadway-West Grand Streetscape Improvement Project

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff has prepared two resolutions to award a construction contract for the Broadway-West Grand Streetscape Improvement Project (C00800) ("Project"):

- The first resolution authorizes the award of a construction contract to Ray's Electric for the Project (C00800) for an amount not-to-exceed Two Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Nine Hundred Six Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$271,906.70) and accepts and appropriates a contribution of Agency funds under the Cooperation Agreement for an amount not-to-exceed Four Hundred Eight Thousand Six Hundred Seven Dollars (\$408,607); and
- The second resolution authorizes a contribution of an amount not-to-exceed Four Hundred Eight Thousand Six Hundred Seven Dollars (\$408,607) from the Central District Redevelopment Project to the City of Oakland under the Cooperation Agreement to fund the construction of the Project.

Ray's Electric is the most responsive and responsible bidder and has met all of the contract requirements. Approval of these resolutions will allow the City to proceed with the Broadway-West Grand Streetscape Improvement Project. This Project includes the replacement of existing deteriorated sidewalk pavement with new sidewalk, including new ADA compliant curb ramps,

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new historic street lighting, replacement street trees, median and landscape improvements, tree grates, bike racks, and trash receptacles along the east side of Broadway from West Grand Avenue to 24<sup>th</sup> Street.

This Project is consistent with the Mayoral and City Council goal to provide clean, well-maintained and accessible streets and sidewalks, facilities, amenities, parks, recreational facilities and trees. The Project is located in Council District 3.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The engineer's estimate for the base bid was \$309,970. The lowest responsive, responsible bidder was Ray's Electric. This resolution will authorize a construction contract in an amount not-to-exceed Two Hundred Seventy One Thousand Nine Hundred Six Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$271,906.70). The project is funded by Central District Redevelopment Agency monies.

The funding for this project will be provided from the Redevelopment Agency to the City under the Cooperation Agreement and totals an amount not-to-exceed Four Hundred Eight Thousand Six Hundred Seven Dollars (\$408,607). These funds will pay for construction, construction contingency, consultant support and CEDA Design and Construction staff time. These funds are located in the Central District Redevelopment Project Subordinated Tax Allocation Bonds Series 2003 Fund (9532), Capital Improvement Project Organization (94800), Structures and Improvements Account (54011), Downtown Streetscape Implementation Project (P128840). These funds will be appropriated to the City in Oakland Redevelopment Agency Projects Fund (7780), Capital Improvement Projects Organization (94800), in a City project to be established for the Broadway-West Grand Streetscape Improvement project.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On May 19, 2008, the Office of the City Clerk received four bids for the project. The Department of Contract Compliance and Purchasing has analyzed the contractor bid data for compliance with City business and employment program requirements. Ray's Electric is the lowest bidder of the four, and also the most responsive and responsible bidder. Ray's Electric has met all of the contract requirements. (See Attachment A – Contract Compliance memo, and Attachment B – Canvass of Bids) Rays Electric has one year to make up the Local Employment goal shortfall and six months to make up the Apprenticeship goal shortfall.

The duration of the work is sixty working days from the date of the Notice to Proceed. With approval of these resolutions, the anticipated start of construction is August 2008 with completion in November 2008. The construction contract specifies \$1,000 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract completion time is extended.

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Broadway-West Grand Streetscape Project includes new and repaired sidewalks on the east side of Broadway from West Grand Avenue to 24<sup>th</sup> Street, ADA compliant handicap access

Item: \_\_\_\_\_ Public Works Committee June 24, 2008 ramps, replacement street trees and tree grates, historic streetlights to replace the Broadway Auto Row light fixtures, median and landscape improvements, street furnishings that include trash receptacles, and bike racks.

#### Coordination with Signature Properties

Signature Properties has offered to assume long-term maintenance responsibilities for the median on Broadway between West Grand and 24<sup>th</sup> Street. A maintenance agreement has been drafted and reviewed by the City Attorney's office and is ready to be executed upon award of this contract. Additionally, Signature Properties has prepared bid documents and is paying to construct enhanced sidewalk improvements at the entry of the YMCA building. Signature Properties is coordinating with the YMCA on this project.

#### KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

#### Environmental Documentation and CEQA Determination:

The City has independently reviewed and considered the environmental determination, and the City finds and determines that the project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 (operation, repair, or minor alteration of existing structures or facilities) or Section 15302 (replacement or reconstruction of existing structures or facilities) of the CEQA guidelines.

#### SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

**Economic**: Project construction will utilize local businesses in accordance with the City of Oakland's business and employment program requirements. This Project will create jobs for Oakland residents, and generate business tax, sales tax, and other revenues for the City from the Project contractors and suppliers. In addition, the Project will enhance the physical appearance of the Broadway-West Grand area of downtown Oakland, which will encourage future economic investment.

*Environmenta*l: Project improvements will enhance the Uptown area by providing additional street trees, newspaper racks, benches, bike racks and trash receptacles, and will enhance conditions for pedestrians and the immediate neighborhood. The Project will incorporate, to the extent feasible, recycled content building materials and explore other environmental opportunities such as waste reduction.

**Social Equity**: The contractor is required to comply with all City of Oakland business and employment program requirements.

#### DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

The Project will be in compliance with the physical access requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act, and will provide equal opportunity and access for pedestrians along the project area. ADA-compliant curb ramps will be installed at seven locations within the project area.

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#### RECOMMENDATIONS AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends that the Council approve the resolution authorizing the City Administrator, or her designee, to award a construction contract to Ray's Electric for an amount not-to-exceed Two Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Nine Hundred-Six Dollars and Seventy-Cents (\$271,906.70) for the Broadway West-Grand Streetscape Improvement Project. Ray's Electric is the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder.

#### ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the following items: (1) a City resolution awarding a construction contract to Ray's Electric for the Project (C00800) for an amount not-to-exceed Two Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Nine Hundred-Six Dollars and Seventy-Cents (\$271,906.70) and accepts and appropriates a contribution of Agency funds under the Cooperation Agreement for an amount not-to-exceed Four Hundred Eight-Thousand Six Hundred-Seven Dollars (\$408,607); and (2) an Agency resolution authorizing a contribution of an amount not-to exceed Four Hundred Eight-Thousand Six Hundred-Seven Dollars (\$408,607) from the Central District Redevelopment Project to the City of Oakland under the Cooperation Agreement to fund the implementation of the Project.



WHEREAS, Section 33445 of the California Health and Safety Code authorizes a redevelopment agency to pay for the cost of installation or construction of publicly-owned facilities, if the legislative body has consented to such funding and has made certain findings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is consenting to the use of Agency funds for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Agency agrees that the City is the Lead Agency for the Project for purposes of environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 ("CEQA"); and

WHEREAS, the requirements of CEQA, the CEQA Guidelines as prescribed by the Secretary for Resources, and the provisions of the Environmental Review Regulations of the City of Oakland have been satisfied; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Agency hereby allocates Four Hundred Eight-Thousand Six Hundred-Seven Dollars (\$408,607) from the Central District Redevelopment Project Subordinated Tax Allocation Bonds 2003 Series Fund (9532), Capital Improvement Projects Organization (94800), Downtown Streetscape Project (P128840) to reimburse the City of Oakland's Oakland Redevelopment Agency Projects Fund (7780), Capital Improvement Projects Organization (94800), in a City Project to be established for the Broadway-West Grand Streetscape Improvement Project under the Cooperation Agreement to fund the Broadway-West Grand Streetscape Improvement Project; and be it

#### FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Agency hereby finds and determines as follows:

- 1. That the funding of the Project will benefit the Central District Redevelopment Project Area by improving the appearance of, and pedestrian safety and access on Broadway from West-Grand to 24<sup>th</sup> Streets;
- 2. That the City Capital Improvement Program ("CIP") funds have been unable to provide financing for the Broadway West-Grand Streetscape Improvement Project in the CIP 2005-2010 Adopted Budget, and therefore no other reasonable means of financing the Project are available to the City other than Redevelopment Agency funding; and
- 3. That the use of tax increment funds from the Central District Redevelopment Project Area for the Broadway West-Grand Streetscape Improvement Project will assist in the elimination of blight in the Central District Project Area by installing streetscape improvements along Broadway that will improve the appearance and functionality of Broadway from West Grand to 24<sup>th</sup> Street, and is consistent with the implementation plan adopted for the Central District Redevelopment Project Area; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Agency finds and determines, based on the information in the staff report accompanying this resolution, that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 (operation, repair, or minor alteration of existing structures or facilities) or Section 15302 (replacement or reconstruction of existing structures or facilities) of the CEQA guidelines; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Agency hereby authorizes the Agency Administrator, or her designee, to take all actions necessary with respect to the Agency funding of the Project in accordance with this Resolution and its basic purposes.
