AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2012

WHEREAS, Oakland City Charter Section 1101 stipulates that a general election be held the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in each even numbered year; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 1101 further authorizes the Council to consolidate the General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Sections 10400 through 10403.5 provides that the Oakland General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2012 may be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same day; now therefore

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Oakland hereby requests that the Board of Supervisors of Alameda County order the consolidation of the City of Oakland General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election; and

Section 2. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary under the law to prepare for and conduct the November 6, 2012 Oakland General Municipal Election and the City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate all monies necessary for the City Clerk to prepare for and conduct said election consistent with the Charter of the City of Oakland, the Oakland Municipal Code and State Elections Code where applicable; and

Section 3. That the City Council of the City of Oakland hereby authorizes and directs the City Clerk, at least 88 days prior to the November 6, 2012 Oakland General Municipal Election to forward certified copies of this ordinance to the Alameda County Board of Supervisors and the Alameda County Registrar of Voters.


