WHEREAS, Patrick W. Haw was promoted to Captain of Police in June 1998, where he served as the Division Commander for the Personnel and Training Division; and

WHEREAS, Patrick W. Haw was promoted to Deputy Chief of Police in October 1999, where he has served as Bureau Commander in the Bureau of Services and the Bureau of Field Operations; and

WHEREAS, Patrick W. Haw has dedicated 22 years of service to the City of Oakland, now therefore be it
