

Resolution Awarding A Contract To The Lowest Bidder, AJW
Construction, For The Construction Of The Citywide Traffic Island
And Bulb-Out In Accordance With Specifications For Project No.
C159720, FY 2005 – 2007, At Santa Clara Avenue At Lakepark

Avenue, Vernon Street At Lee Street, Joaquin Miller Road At Robinson Drive, Pierson Street Between Macarthur Boulevard And Redding Street, Park Boulevard At El Centro Avenue, And Three Or More Other Pending Locations, In The Amount Of Five Hundred Three

Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$503,185.00)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator to award a construction contract to AJW Construction for the Citywide Traffic Island and Bulb-Out Project No. C159720, FY 2005-2007. The contractor will install traffic islands or bulb-outs at Santa Clara Avenue/Lakepark Avenue, Vernon Street/Lee Street, Joaquin Miller Road/Robinson Drive, Pierson Street between Macarthur Boulevard and Redding Street, and Park Boulevard/El Centro Avenue. In addition, the contract includes a \$150,000.00 allowance for as-needed traffic island or bulb-out work at other locations pending final community consensus/engineering design for a total project amount of \$503,185.00.

Appropriations for the projects were approved through the FY 2005-2007 Capital Improvement Program. These islands and bulb-outs project is in response to numerous community requests for traffic calming and school safety in the respective neighborhoods. Measure B Funds (2211) are available and identified below for the total project amount.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total project budget is \$673,500.00, and the amount allocated to construction, including contingency, is \$553,500.00. The resolution will authorize a \$503,185.00 contract with AJW Construction. The contract includes an additional as-needed contract in the amount of \$150,000.00 for more traffic island and bulb-outs pending final community consensus/engineering design, before the end of the term of construction. Funds are available from Measure B in the following accounts:

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

On July 23, 2007, the City Clerk opened five bids for the project. AJW Construction (Oakland), Ray's Electric (Oakland), Redgwick Construction (Newark, CA), Vanguard Construction (Livermore, CA), and Sposeto Engineering (Union City, CA) submitted bids of \$503,185.00, \$516,300.00, \$527,978.00, \$619,213.00, and \$700,147.00, respectively.

On August 6, 2007, the Office of the City Administrator, Contract Compliance & Employment Services Division, determined that AJW Construction is the lowest responsible and responsive bidder. AJW Construction meets the City's 20% Local/Small Local Business Enterprise Program participation requirement and is also compliant with the Equal Benefit Ordinance. Attachment A presents supporting documentation from Contract Compliance & Employment Services and Contract Administration.

Execution of a contract after Council approval will take approximately six weeks, resulting in a projected construction start date in early November, 2007. The construction is scheduled for 85 days. The contractor will be assessed \$500.00 in liquidated damages per working day over the 85-day schedule, barring unforeseen circumstances including inclement weather.

The project locations and treatments were derived from citizens' requests, Council input, and community collaboration. Subsequent to developing a conceptual design, staff attended several meetings with neighborhood representatives to present the projects and to build consensus. At the time the contract went out for bid, all the requests that staff had received for traffic islands or bulb-outs, and meeting engineering requirements were included in this project.

The traffic bulb-out at Vernon Street and Lee Street includes landscaping which the community has agreed to maintain through the City's Adopt-a-Spot Program. However, the program is not binding, and should the landscape fall into disrepair, it will be converted to maintenance-free hardscape.

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The work consists of installing:

- a traffic island on Pierson Street between MacArthur Boulevard and Redding Street (District 6);
- traffic bulb-outs on Santa Clara Avenue at Lakepark Avenue (District 2), Vernon Street at Lee Street (District 3), Joaquin Miller Road at Robinson Drive (District 4); and
- an allowance for additional traffic islands or bulb-outs up to \$150,000.00. The allowance for this additional work will enables the City to construct about three or more additional traffic islands or bulb-outs at a faster schedule.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The construction work will be done by a local construction firm.

Environmental: These pedestrian safety improvements will encourage greater neighborhood foot travel and reduce reliance on motor vehicles.

Social Equity: Senior citizens, persons with disabilities, and children will benefit from these improvements.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

The traffic bulb-outs will reduce the roadway crossing distance and increase sight distance for disabled and senior citizens. The bulb-outs also replace existing wheelchair ramps with new ones that include detectable warning domes.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends that City Council approve the resolution awarding a construction contract to AJW Construction for the Citywide Traffic Island and Bulb-Out Project FY 2005-2007 in the amount of \$503,185.00.

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ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.

All firms are EBO compliant except Redgwick Construction.

RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO THE LOWEST BIDDER, AJW CONSTRUCTION, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CITYWIDE TRAFFIC ISLAND AND BULB-OUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SPECIFICATIONS FOR PROJECT NO. WHEREAS, on July 23, 2007, five (5) bids were received by the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Oakland for the Citywide Traffic Island and Bulb-Out Project FY 2005-2007 (City Project No. C159720); and

WHEREAS, AJW Construction submitted the lowest responsible and responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds for the construction contract in Measure B Funds (2211); and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that this contract is in the public interest because of economy and/or best performance; and

WHEREAS, AJW Construction complies with all Local/Small Local Business Enterprise Program requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that services under this contract will be temporary and shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the construction contract for the Citywide Traffic Island and Bulb-Out Project 2005-2007 (City Project No. C159720) is hereby awarded to AJW Construction in accordance with

the specifications for said project and terms of its bid, dated July 23, 2007, in the amount of five hundred three thousand one hundred eighty-five dollars (\$503,185.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved for form and legality by the City Attorney, and a copy of the contract shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to post conspicuously forthwith notice of the above award on the official bulletin board in the Office of the City Clerk.
