RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF ERNEST JOLLY, RICK MOSS, AND CHERIE NEWELL TO THE CULTURAL AFFAIRS COMMISSION'S PUBLIC ART ADVISORY COMMITTEE

**WHEREAS**, on February 28, 1989, the City of Oakland adopted Ordinance No. 11086 C.M.S. which established a Percent for Art Public Art Program; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 11086 C.M.S. defines the Public Art Advisory Committee as a professionally qualified citizen advisory committee to the Cultural Affairs Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 11086 C.M.S. also defines that the members of the Public Art Advisory Committee are recommended by the Cultural Affairs Commission and approved by City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, two vacancies exist on the Public Art Advisory Committee and one member is currently serving in hold-over capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Art Advisory Committee has recruited and recommended two members of the Oakland arts community to serve on the Committee and a current member to move from hold-over status to a full term, in compliance with Public Art Advisory Committee membership policy; and

**WHEREAS**, Ernest Jolly and Rick Moss were unanimously recommended for appointment by the Public Art Advisory Committee at the November 3, 2003, regular meeting and current member Cherie Newell was recommended for a full term appointment; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 17, 2003, the Cultural Affairs Commission forwarded these three individuals to the City Council for appointment; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, that these three individuals bring aesthetic, professional, gender and cultural diversity to the Public Art Advisory Committee and represent a variety of skills and knowledge in art practice, administration and conservation; and be it
