RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$69,524) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF JUSTICE (USDOJ/NIJ) FOR THE 2005 FORENSIC CASEWORK DNA BACKLOG REDUCTION PROGRAM IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, grant funds totaling \$69,524 have been awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice, National Institute of Justice to support the Police Department's 2005 Forensic Casework DNA Backlog Reduction Program; and

WHEREAS, the Forensic Casework DNA Backlog Reduction Program was created to assist laboratories in reducing the number of cases in their backlog in which DNA analyses may be conducted on biological evidence; and

WHEREAS, the proposed grant does not allow for any indirect costs (Central Services Overhead) charges in the amount of \$10,492, and the Department has requested a waiver of said charges; and

WHEREAS, the grant term for the proposed initiative is October 1, 2005 through September 30, 2006; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept grant funds in the amount of \$69,524 from the U.S. Department of Justice, National Institute of Justice and to increase revenues and appropriate said budget to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said grant funds shall be maintained in the Federal Grant Fund: 2112; Criminalistics Division Org.: 102610; Criminalistics Program PS05; in a Project Number to be established; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That Central Services Overhead costs of \$10,492 (17.77%) are hereby waived; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award.
