

NOTICE AND DIGEST

ORDINANCE: (A) AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 13654 C.M.S (WHICH ADOPTED THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 MASTER FEE SCHEDULE), AS AMENDED, TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR CHARGING ELECTRIC VEHICLES, (B) AMENDING MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 10.48.010(B) TO ADD FINES FOR PARKING A VEHICLE IN AN ELECTRIC CHARGING DESIGNATED SPACE WHILE NOT CONNECTED FOR ELECTRIC CHARGING PURPOSES; AND (C) ADOPTING APPROPRIATE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) FINDINGS

The amended Ordinance No. 13645 (which adopted the Fiscal Year 2022-23 Master Fee Schedule) will establish fees for charging electric vehicles at city-owned chargers. In addition, the amended Municipal Code Section 10.48010 adds fines for parking a vehicle in an electric charging designated space while not connected for electric charging purposes. This ordinance adopts the appropriate California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) findings for both.
