RESOLUTION APPOINTING JO ELLEN SPENCER AS A MEMBER OF THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 11996 C.M.S. creates the Health and Human Services Commission, whose members are nominated by the Mayor and approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 11996 C.M.S. specifies that members of the Health and Human Services Commission are to serve three year terms, which are to be staggered so that one or two appointments will expire every year, and appointments to fill a term of office are only to be for the remainder of that term; and

WHEREAS, the term(s) of Ms. Spencer will expire on November 18, 2000;

Now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, that by the nomination of the Mayor, the following individual is hereby appointed to the term set forth below:

Jo Ellen Spencer, to complete the term beginning November 18, 2000 and ending October 22, 2003, filling the position formerly held by herself.
