FACTS/ISSUES:

Plaintiff Philip Woodruff ("Woodruff") alleges that on October 28, 2020, they tripped on an uneven sidewalk in front of 4050 Piedmont Avenue in Oakland, California. Woodruff alleges that the sidewalk was deteriorated and there was an uplift causing them to fall forward.

Woodruff tore their left rotator cuff and had arthroscopic surgery to repair it. Woodruff's past medical expenses are approximately \$53,000. Additionally, Woodruff claims damages for pain and suffering.

The City determined that settlement in the amount of \$30,000 on behalf of the City to Woodruff, without admitting liability and to avoid further litigation, is in the best interest of the City.
