ACCEPTANCE RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ÁND APPROPRIATION OF REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000), UNDER THE AGENCY/CITY COOPERATION AGREEMENT, TO CONDUCT POLICE OPERATIONS AGAINST HUMAN TRAFFICKING **INTERNATIONAL BOULEVARD** THE **COLISEUM** ON IN REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA

WHEREAS, in 2004, and in 2007, the Police Department was collectively awarded funds in the amount of \$700,000 (Resolution No. 792575 C.M.S. and Resolution No. 80893 C.M.S.) from the U.S. Department of Justice Human Trafficking Grant to purchase necessary investigative equipment, provide training on regional and local levels to law enforcement personnel and the community, and to conduct human trafficking operations/investigations in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Police Department has aggressively combated Domestic Human Trafficking, in particular, Child Prostitution for nearly four years due (in part) by the funding provided by a U.S. Department of Justice Human Trafficking Grant, which is now exhausted; and

WHEREAS, the Department's efforts to conduct investigative operations will be severely compromised as result of the depleted grant funding; and

WHEREAS, since 1999, the Police Department has made significant efforts to address the growing number of children (runaways in particular) being arrested for prostitution in the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, weekly human tracking investigative operations conducted throughout various targeted locations in the City have resulted in 122 children being rescued from exploiters and 57 offenders being arrested and charged with a range of felonies at both the state and federal levels; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Redevelopment Agency entered into a Cooperation Agreement on July 1, 2004, which governs the provision of assistance and the payment of funds between the two agencies, including Agency assistance to City services serving a redevelopment purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency has authorized a contribution of redevelopment funds in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 to the City under the Cooperation Agreement to conduct supplemental police operations against human trafficking on International Boulevard in the Coliseum Redevelopment Project Area; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 in the Coliseum Operations Fund (9450), Coliseum Redevelopment Organization (88659), Coliseum-Staff Project (S82600) for these operations to continue during the period of May 12, 2009 through June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the requested funds would be used to conduct supplemental operations within the Coliseum Redevelopment Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the results of these operations will be documented in official Department "After Action" reports available to City and Department authorities; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby accepts Redevelopment Agency funds in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 under the Cooperation Agreement to conduct supplemental police operations against human trafficking on International Boulevard in the Coliseum Redevelopment Project Area; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That Council hereby appropriates \$100,000 of Coliseum Redevelopment Area funds to the Oakland Redevelopment Agency Projects Fund (7780), Family Services Division Organization (102350), Coliseum Project (C82620); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to take any action with respect to police operations against human trafficking on International Boulevard in the Coliseum Redevelopment Project Area consistent with this Resolution and its basic purposes.
