

RE: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO ANDES

CONSTRUCTION, INC., FOR THE ON CALL SANITARY SEWERS AND STORM DRAINS EMERGENCY PROJECTS (PROJECT NO. C219530) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXTEND THE CONTRACTFOR AN ADDITIONAL YEAR FOR THE AMOUNT OF

TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Manager to award a construction contract in the amount of \$250,000 to Andes Construction, Inc., (Oakland) for the On Call Sanitary Sewers and Storm Drains Emergency Projects (Project No. C219530) and authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and extend the contract for an additional year for an additional amount of \$250,000.

Funding for this project is included in the \$2.1 million FY2002-03 Capital Improvement Program for cyclic replacement of aging or defective sewers and related structures throughout the City. Each year, the City hires contractors to complete numerous small projects that require the use of equipment, materials, and labor that are not available from the PWA Maintenance Department.

FISCAL IMPACTS

There are sufficient funds in the project budget for the work. Funding for this project is available in the Sewer Service Fund (3100); Organization (92244); Account (57417); Project (C219530). The engineer's estimate for the work is \$250,000.

BACKGROUND

Each year, the City completes numerous small emergency repairs to its public infrastructure. The City does not have the necessary equipment to perform this work and contracts for its construction. Each contract requires plans, specifications, an engineer's estimate, and bid and contract documents.

To reduce response time and to make the construction process more efficient, three years ago, staff prepared a comprehensive "on-call construction services" project that included the most typical repair work. The project allowed the City to expedite repairs in a timely manner without having to bid each repair with a formal contract. The project was extremely successful, and this contract is a continuance of the program. Staff intends to seek authorization for this program from the Council every year. However, it is recommended that the Council authorizes a one-year extension of the contract, if deemed necessary, to allow for dealing with future emergency projects.





The contract includes a wide variety of typical public works contract items, such as installing liner in existing sewer pipe, in-place pipe expanding for existing pipe, removing and replacing existing pipe with various pipe material and sizes, reconnecting house connection sewer, constructing appurtenant sewer structures such as manholes and cleanouts, point repairs, pothole for utilities, and miscellaneous concrete work.

Staff prepared bid documents with contract unit quantities for the purposes of comparing bids. Actual quantities and final payments will be based on actual work as directed to be done by the City for an amount of \$250,000. On August 11, 2003, the City Clerk received one bid for the project. The bid, based on assumed unit quantities, was for \$298,877 as shown on *Attachment A*. The responsible bidder, Andes Construction, Inc., (Oakland) with a bid amount of \$298,877, is recommended for award. Staff has reviewed the bid and believes that the unit costs are reasonable for the work anticipated.

This project meets the Mayor / City Council and Citywide Objectives to Maintain and Enhance Oakland's Physical Assets.

Under the proposed bid from Andes Construction, Inc., the SLBE participation is \$277,810 (100%) and the Local Trucking participation is \$7,500 (100%). Both percentages exceed the City's 50% SLBE and 50 % Local Trucking goals. Also, the contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents. The LBE/SLBE information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Manager's Office and is shown in *Attachment B*.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Construction under this contract is scheduled to begin in October 2003 and be completed by October 2004. The project schedule is shown in *Attachment A*.

Staff has reviewed the submitted bid for this work and determined that the low bid is reasonable.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents.



Environmental: The replacement of the sanitary sewers will eliminate the possibility of sewer leakage and overflows and thus prevent potential harm to groundwater resources and the bay. The contractor will be required to make every effort to reuse clean fill materials and use recyclable concrete and asphalt products.

Social Equity: This is a citywide program and all residents of Oakland will benefit from this project.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

There is no direct impact or benefit to seniors or people with disabilities.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

It is recommended that the construction contract be awarded to Andes Construction, Inc., the only responsible bidder, in the amount of \$250,000 for the On Call Sanitary Sewers and Storm Drains Emergency Projects. Andes Construction, Inc. has met the local business requirements, and there are sufficient funds in the project account. It is also recommended that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and extend the contract for another one-year period, if necessary, to save time and effort in dealing with unexpected conditions.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO ANDES CONSTRUCTION, INC., FOR THE ON CALL SANITARY SEWERS AND STORM DRAINS EMERGENCY PROJECTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXTEND THE CONTRACT FOR AN ADDITIONAL YEAR FOR SANITARY SEWERS, STORM DRAINS AND RELATED WORK (CITY PROJECT C219530) FOR THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000)

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2003, one bid was received by the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Oakland for the On Call Sanitary Sewers and Storm Drains Emergency Projects C219530; and

WHEREAS, Andes Construction, Inc., is the only responsible bidder for the project and has met the SLBE requirements; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in the project budget for work, and the project budget includes \$250,000 for the construction work, and the engineer's estimate for the work is \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the contract for the On Call Sanitary Sewers and Storm Drains Emergency Projects is hereby awarded to Andes Construction: Inc., in accordance with the terms of its bid therefore, dated August 11, 2003, for the amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the plans and specifications prepared by the Director of Public Works for this project are hereby approved; and be it

ORA/COUNCIL OCT 2 1 2003 **FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the amount of the bond for faithful performance, \$125,000, and the amount for a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials furnished and for the amount due under the Unemployment Insurance Act, \$250,000: with respect to such work are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Andes Construction, Inc., on behalf of the City of Oakland and to execute any amendments or modifications of said contract; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and extend this contract for an additional year for Sanitary Sewers, Storm Drains and Related Work and for an additional amount of \$250,000 and incorporating all other terms and conditions of the contract; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all other bids are hereby rejected; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the approval of this resolution requires a two-thirds vote of the Council members.
