RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PLAZA PARK FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$378,000

WHEREAS, construction documents for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Plaza Park Project (Project No.G136960) have been prepared and construction bids will be received on June 23, 2003; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to expedite the award of a construction contract in order to minimize potential construction delays, and to be substantially complete prior to the holiday season; and

WHEREAS, the Martin Luther King, Jr. Plaza project is consistent with City Council Budget Goal of "Renewed Infrastructure", and

WHEREAS, the construction contract will be for an amount not to exceed \$378,000 including a construction contingency; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for the project; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to award a construction contract on behalf of the City of Oakland for Martin Luther King, Jr. Plaza Park project ("project") to the lowest, responsible, and responsive bidder, in accordance with the terms of its bid, for an amount not to exceed three hundred seventy eight thousand dollars (\$378,000), and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That if the initial bids are non-responsive, the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to reject all bids, informally re-bid and/or negotiate a contract on behalf of the City of Oakland for this project for an amount not to exceed three hundred seventy eight thousand dollars (\$378,000); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to reject all other bids and to execute any amendments or modifications of said contract within the limitations of the project specifications; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That this resolution requires the two-thirds vote of the Council.
