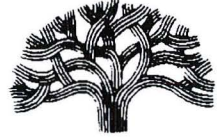

Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled claim for Two Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$265,000.00), payable to Nina Wiley.

This action arises out of Ms. Wiley's injuries which she alleges that she sustained due to the condition of the City's property.

The Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Tuesday, October 6, 2015 (moved by Councilmember Rebecca Kaplan and seconded by Councilmember Noel Gallo - 7 Ayes, 1 Absent – President Gibson McElhaney.



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF NINA WILEY v. CITY OF OAKLAND, ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. RG13669229 CITY ATTORNEY'S FILE NO. 29283, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$265,000.00) (OAKLAND PUBLIC WORKS—DANGEROUS CONDITION)

WHEREAS, Nina Wiley alleges that she incurred damages as a result of an injury that she sustained due to the condition of a public property; and

WHEREAS, Nina Wiley, filed a personal-injury lawsuit against the City; and

WHEREAS, without admitting fault or wrongdoing, the City has determined to compromise and settle Nina Wiley's claims against it for the sum of Two Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$265,000.00) payable by the City of Oakland; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City of Oakland is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of Nina Wiley v. City of Oakland, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG13669229, City Attorney's File No. 29283, for a sum not to exceed Two Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$265,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of Two Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$265,000.00) be paid to Nina Wiley.
