RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$177,600) FROM THE PORT OF OAKLAND, BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS, TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A MARINE PATROL VESSEL AND COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE MARINE UNIT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PORT SECURITY OF **OAKLAND** WATERWAYS **AND AUTHORIZING** DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE PORT OF OAKLAND FROM **NOVEMBER** 1. 2005 TO **OCTOBER** 2008 FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the Marine Unit of the Oakland Police Department is the City's designated regulator of waterway security in and around the City of Oakland including the Estuary and Oakland International Airport waterside; and

WHEREAS, members of the Marine Unit currently patrol City of Oakland waterways with two small boats that are 20 years old and require extensive maintenance of both vessels and engines; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Oakland has agreed to provide funds in the amount of \$177,600 to the City of Oakland for use by the Oakland Police Department Marine Unit to purchase a new marine patrol vessel and communications equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar funds by Resolution No. 79374 C.M.S., dated July 19, 2005; and

WHEREAS, upon purchase of the new police marine vessel the Oakland Police Department will sell one or both of the small police boats currently used by the Department for an estimated \$30,000 - \$60,000 which will be applied toward future maintenance expenses of the new marine vessel; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator or her designee to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Port of Oakland and accept \$177,600 and appropriate said funds to the Police Department's Special Operations Section, Marine Unit; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the monies shall be maintained in Oakland Police Department General Fund (1010), Special Operations Organization Code (105610), Account Project to be determined, and Program Code (PS13); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That revenues generated from the sale of the small police boat(s) currently used by the Department will be deposited into the Oakland Police Department General Fund (1010), Special Operations Organization Code (105610), Special Operations Division Program Code (PS13), and Account Project to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator as agent of the City to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the award.
