

RESOLUTION APPROVING SETTLEMENT OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA RIVER WATCH, ET AL. V. OAKLAND MARITIME SUPPORT SERVICES, INC., (OMSS) ET AL. (U.S. DISTRICT COURT, NORTHERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA, CASE NO. 4:40-CV-3912 CW) BY PAYING A TOTAL OF \$300,000.00, WITH \$200,000.00 OF THAT SUM TO BE ALLOCATED TO THE WEST OAKLAND JOB RESOURCES CENTER AND \$100,000.00 TO BE ALLOCATED TO RESOLVE PLAINTIFFS' STATUTORY CLAIM FOR ATTORNEYS' FEES IN EXCHANGE FOR PLAINTIFFS' DISMISSAL OF THE LITIGATION AND AGREEMENT NOT TO CHALLENGE CERTAIN ACTIONS RELATED TO RELOCATION OF THE OMSS FACILITY (OFFICE OF THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR - CLEAN WATER ACT)

WHEREAS, Oakland Maritime Support Services, Inc. ("OMSS") is a corporation under the laws of the State of California that operated a transportation support services facility located at 11 Burma Road in Oakland, (the "Facility"), a portion of which is subject to State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order No. 97-03-DWQ, National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit No. CAS0000001, Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Storm Water Associated with Industrial Activities Excluding Construction Activities (the "General Permit"); and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Oakland (the "Redevelopment Agency") was a public body, created pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment law and the owner the real property on which the Facility was located at the time the alleged violations that are the subject of Plaintiffs' complaint allegedly occurred; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland (the "City") originally was named as a defendant in this action and is now the owner of the real property on which the Facility was located; and

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2013 the City Council considered and authorized a settlement of the Action in which the City would pay a total of \$300,000.00 to resolve all Plaintiffs' claims, with \$200,000.00 of that sum to be allocated to fund the West Oakland Job Resources Center and \$100,000.00 of that sum to be allocated to resolve Plaintiffs'

statutory claim for attorneys' fees in exchange for Plaintiffs' dismissal of the Action and agreement not to challenge certain future actions related to relocation of the OMSS facility to a site proximate to the Oakland Army Base and/or the Port of Oakland; now therefore be it resolved

RESOLVED: That The City Attorney is authorized and directed to settle the matter of *Northern California River Watch, et al. v. Oakland Maritime Support Services, Inc., et al.* (U.S. District Court, Northern District of California, Case No. 4:40-CV-3912-CW) and to pay out the sum of \$300,000.00, with \$200,000.00 of that sum to be allocated to fund the West Oakland Job Resources Center and \$100,000.00 of that sum to be allocated to resolve Plaintiffs' statutory claim for attorneys' fees; in exchange for Plaintiffs' dismissal of the Action and agreement not to challenge certain future actions related to relocation of the OMSS facility to a site proximate to the Oakland Army Base and/or the Port of Oakland.


