## INTRODUCED BY MAYOR BARBARA LEE

## A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S REAPPOINTMENT OF FATIMAH AURE TO THE COMMISSION ON PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

**WHEREAS,** Ordinance No. 9968 C.M.S., adopted August 5, 1980, and amended by Ordinance No. 11864 C.M.S., adopted March 12, 1996, and then by Ordinance No. 13334 C.M.S., adopted October 20, 2015, created the Commission on Persons with Disabilities to address issues germane to accessibility, services and civil rights for persons with disabilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission on Persons with Disabilities consists of eleven (11) members, serving three-year staggered terms with no more than two consecutive terms; and

WHEREAS, at least a majority of the Commission members appointed must be persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Barbara Lee has reappointed Fatimah Aure to the Commission on Persons with Disabilities, subject to confirmation by the City Council; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**: That pursuant to City Charter Section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment to the Commission on Persons with Disabilities:

**Fatimah Aure,** to serve a three-year term beginning September 3, 2025, and ending September 2, 2028, filling a vacant seat previously held by herself.
