A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT THE DONATION OF A GELDING HORSE VALUED AT TWENTY-SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$26,000) FOR USE BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S MOUNTED PATROL UNIT

WHEREAS, the Hodgkinson family wishes to contribute a gelding horse valued at \$26,000 to the Police Department's Mounted Patrol Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department needs to replace a police horse that is no longer able to perform patrol duties; and

WHEREAS, the contribution of the horse will provide an animal which is needed for the Police Department Mounted Patrol Unit, but which is not otherwise budgeted; and

WHEREAS, should this horse be unable to meet required performance standards or when this horse reaches retirement the Hodgkinson family shall have first right of refusal of the animal; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council accepts the donation of a gelding horse from the Hodgkinson family and thanks them for their generous donation to and their support of the Oakland Police Department.
