RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO ANDES CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE REHABILITATION OF SANITARY SEWERS IN THE AREA BOUNDED BY CREST, MICHIGAN AND 82ND AVENUES AND MACARTHUR BOULEVARD - SUBBASIN 84-112 (PROJECT NO. C158110) FOR THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE THOUSAND FIFTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$1,271,051)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator to award a construction contract in the amount of \$1,271,051 to Andes Construction, Inc. for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the Area Bounded by Crest, Michigan and 82nd Avenues and MacArthur Boulevard – Subbasin 84-112 (Project No. C158110). The work to be completed under this project is part of the City's annual sanitary sewer rehabilitation program. The work is located in Council Districts 6 and 7.

FISCAL IMPACT

There are sufficient funds in the project budget for the work. Funding for this project is available in the Sewer Service Fund (3100); Capital Project-Sanitary Sewer Design Organization (92244); Sewers Account (57417); Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the Area Bounded by Crest, Michigan and 82nd Avenues and MacArthur Boulevard – Subbasin 84-112 Project (C158110). These funds were specifically allocated for this project. The Engineer's estimate for the work is \$1,537,975.

BACKGROUND

On November 15, 2004, the City Clerk received three bids for this project in the amounts of \$1,271,051, \$1,444,235 and \$1,904,000 as shown in *Attachment A*. The lowest responsible bidder, Andes Construction, Inc., is recommended for award.

This project will rehabilitate and upgrade the sanitary sewers within the project area, eliminate the infiltration of rain and groundwater into the sanitary sewer system and limit the overflows and backups during wet weather. This project meets the Mayor/Council Goals and Citywide

Objective to maintain and enhance Oakland's physical assets by providing for well-maintained sanitary sewer systems.

In general, the proposed work consists of rehabilitating/replacing approximately 18,900 linear feet of existing sewer pipes ranging from 8" to 12" diameter; rehabilitating or replacing over 60 sewer structures; reconnecting house connection sewers; rehabilitating house connection sewers; and other related works as indicated on the plans and specifications.

Under the proposed contract with Andes Construction, Inc., SLBE participation of \$1,271,051 (100%) exceeds the City's 20% LBE/SLBE goal. The contractor shows \$35,000 (100%) for trucking that exceeds the 20% Local Trucking participation goal. The contractor received 5% credit for LBE/SLBE preference, or \$63,552.55, that made the adjusted bid amount \$1,207,498.45. The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents. The LBE/SLBE information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Administrator's Office and is shown in *Attachment B*.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Construction is scheduled to begin in June 2005 and should be completed by December 2005. The contract specifies \$1,000 in liquidated damages per working day if the contract completion time of 120 working days is exceeded. The project schedule is shown in *Attachment A*.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

<u>Economic</u>: The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents.

<u>Environmental</u>: The replacement of the sanitary sewers will eliminate the possibility of sewer leakage and overflows and thus prevent potential harm to groundwater resources and the bay. The contractor will be required to make every effort to reuse clean fill materials and use recyclable concrete and asphalt products.

<u>Social Equity:</u> This project is part of the citywide program to eliminate wastewater overflows thereby benefiting all Oakland residents.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

There is no direct impact or benefit to seniors or people with disabilities.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

It is recommended that the construction contract be awarded to Andes Construction Inc., the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of \$1,271,051 for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the Area Bounded by Crest, Michigan and 82nd Avenues and MacArthur Boulevard – Subbasin 84-112 (Project No. C158110). Andes Construction, Inc. has met the LBE/SLBE requirements, and there are sufficient funds in the project account.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to post conspicuously forthwith notice of the above award on the official bulletin board in the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the approval of this resolution requires a two-thirds vote of the Council members.
