ADOPT A RESOLUTION IN REMEMBRANCE OF THE GHOST SHIP FIRE TRAGEDY ONE YEAR LATER; AND A MOMENT OF REFLECTION AND SILENCE
WHEREAS, on December 2, 2016 the lives of 36 people from diverse backgrounds were tragically cut short by the Ghost Ship fire at 1315 31st Avenue; and
WHEREAS, the Ghost Ship fire was one of the City's most devastating, and left many families and communities with tremendous loss; and
WHEREAS, on January 23, 2017, the City Council declared that December 2 nd shall be known annually as Ghost Ship Remembrance Day in Oakland, in perpetuity (Resolution No. 86571); and
WHEREAS, nearly one year later, we acknowledge and honor the ongoing grief brought by the tragedy and that the City of Oakland continues to heal; now, therefore be it
RESOLVED: That the City of Oakland remembers the Ghost Ship fire one year later with a moment of reflection and silence.
