RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CALIFORNIA DEMOCRACY ACT, AN INITIATIVE FOR THE NOVEMBER 2010 BALLOT, THAT WOULD REQUIRE ALL STATE LEGISLATIVE ACTION ON REVENUE AND BUDGET BE PASSED BY A MAJORITY VOTE

WHEREAS, the California State Constitution currently requires that all budget and revenue legislation pass both the state Assembly and the state Senate by a 2/3 vote; and

WHEREAS, the practical effect of this requirement is that 1/3 + 1 or a 34% minority of legislators in either house can prevent passage of budget and revenue legislation; and

WHEREAS, California is one of only three states, and is the largest and most diverse state, with this requirement; and

WHEREAS, the recent consequences of this constitutional requirement has been for a minority of legislators to prevent California from effectively addressing its current financial crisis, catastrophically undermining the ability of the majority of elected state legislators to meet California's needs in health care. education, physical infrastructure, and public safety, and

WHEREAS, local governments, cities, counties, and school districts have been forced to reduce necessary services and functions with consequent adverse effects on Californians; and

WHEREAS, this 2/3 requirement can be changed to simple majority by ballot initiative; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council endorses the California Democracy Act and encourages eligible Oakland residents to sign the petition to place it on the November 2010 ballot; and

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council will inform Bay Area City Councils of this action and invite them to support the Act
