RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-NINE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-FOUR CENTS (\$54,829.54) FROM THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, BERKELEY, SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH, TRAFFIC SAFETY CENTER, SERVING AS THE FISCAL AGENT FOR THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY, FOR THE 2010 SOBRIETY CHECKPOINT PROGRAM TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PROJECT TERM OF OCTOBER 1, 2010 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2011, AND WAIVE CENTRAL SERVICES OVERHEAD CHARGES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS AWARD

WHEREAS, grant funds totaling \$54,829.54 have been awarded by the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, for the Police Department's continued participation in the Sobriety Checkpoint Program; and

WHEREAS, the Sobriety Checkpoint Program is designed to reduce the number of people injured or killed in alcohol-involved crashes through the combined efforts of the Office of Traffic Safety and local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Sobriety Checkpoint mobilization project dates are December 17, 2010 – January 2, 2011, and August 19, 2011 – September 5, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the proposed grant does not allow for indirect costs (Central Services Overhead) charges in the amount of \$7,478.75, and the Department is requesting a waiver of said charges; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 81750 C.M.S., dated January 6, 2009, Resolution No. 80957 C.M.S., dated December 4, 2007, Resolution No. 80280 C.M.S. dated December 5, 2006, Resolution No. 78970 C.M.S. dated December 21, 2004 and; Resolution No. 78253 C.M.S., dated December 16, 2003 now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council does hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to accept and appropriate grant funds in the amount of \$54,829.54 from the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, and to increase revenues and appropriate said budget to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the grant funds shall be maintained in the State of California Grant Fund: 2999, Traffic Enforcement Division Org.: 107510; Traffic Enforcement Program: PS14, in a Project to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That Central Services Overhead costs of \$7,478.75 are hereby waived; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations and related actions and to sign all applications and agreements that may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned grant.
