

RESOLUTION WAIVING CITY'S COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS FOR A SMALL PAY-GO FUNDED PURCHASE IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE THOUSAND AND EIGHT DOLLARS (\$3,008.00) FOR REFLECTIVE DECALS TO IMPROVE TRAIL SIGNAGE VISIBILITY AT JOAQUIN MILLER PARK

WHEREAS, the Joaquin Miller Park Working Group identified as a high priority the need for better signage along Joaquin Miller Park's miles of trails to assist visitors' finding their way throughout the park and to better inform users about trail guidelines; and

WHEREAS: A quantity of reflective decals to improve safety and signage have been purchased for the benefit of Joaquin Miller Park; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Jean Quan wishes to reimburse this provider out of her pay-go fund account; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interests to waive the City's bidding requirements and reimburse Voss Signs LLC, an outside vendor, for they are a specialized provider of outdoor trail signage for this purpose; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: Pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 2.04.050.I.5, the City Council finds and determines that for the reasons set forth above it is in the City's best interests to waive the City's competitive bidding requirements for this purchase and so waives the requirement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City administrator is authorized to purchase on behalf of Councilmember Jean Quan the following materials without competitive bids: Three thousand eight dollars (\$3008.00) from Voss Signs LLC for Reflective Sign Decals, to be charged to the Councilmember's pay-go account.


