Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter and the action of the City Council at its March 7, 2006 closed session, the City Attorney has prepared a resolution authorizing and recommends settlement of the above-captioned matter for the sum of Twenty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500), payable to Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART) and its attorneys, Hedani, Choy, Spalding & Salvagione, LLP.

This is an indemnity action for reimbursement of attorneys' fees and costs incurred in BART's defense of a July 13, 2001 trip and fall accident on College Avenue.

The above settlement is recommended to avoid the risk of an adverse verdict should the matter proceed to trial.
