Supplemental Report To A Resolution Adopting A Redevelopment Agency Public Safety And Police Services Program For The Broadway/MacArthur/San Pablo, Central City East, Central District, Coliseum, And West Oakland Redevelopment Projects For An Amount Not-To-Exceed \$5,202,000 Of Previously-Allocated Redevelopment Funds For FY 2007-09 And An Additional Allocated Amount Not-To-Exceed \$327,250 For The Broadway/MacArthur/San Pablo Redevelopment Project Area

#### **SUMMARY**

As directed by the Public Safety Committee on October 23, 2007, staff has prepared a supplemental report detailing the spending plan associated with the allocation of funds in the amount of \$5,202,000 adopted as a part of the Fiscal Year 2007-09 Adopted Oakland Redevelopment Agency (ORA) Budget.

### FISCAL IMPACT

Spending Plan

As previously stated, \$5,202,000 in Redevelopment Agency funds were allocated to fund 12 new police officers, one sergeant, and their associated costs including (but not limited to) equipment and vehicles in four redevelopment project areas.

Included in this supplemental report is:

- 1. A break down of equipment vs. salaries for the \$5,202,000 and the Project Area Committee recommended allocation for \$327,250 for the Broadway/MacArthur /San Pablo Redevelopment Area; and
- 2. A break down of officer and sergeant salaries and overhead costs.

Both the CEDA Redevelopment Division and OPD have contributed to the development of this report.

Officer deployment within assigned areas will be determined by crime trends and input from the Project Area Committees, with a particular focus on the crucial commercial corridors. Within each redevelopment project area, the enhanced enforcement is subject to change after review of crime statistics and Project Area Committee recommendations.

As in the October 23, 2007 report, CEDA and OPD staff request passage of the Redevelopment Agency resolution adopting a Public Safety and Police Services Program for the four project areas for an amount not-to-exceed \$5,202,000 of previously-allocated redevelopment funds for FY 2007-09, and allocating an additional amount not-to-exceed \$327,250 from Broadway MacArthur/San Pablo Redevelopment Area for the Program.
