Re: Supplemental Information to A Report and Proposed Resolution Authorizing the City Administrator, on Behalf of the City of Oakland, to Accept and Appropriate Grant Funds in an Amount Not to Exceed Three Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$329,700) from the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, for Implementation of the Fiscal Year 2010 Selective Traffic Enforcement Program in the Police Department

STEP Operations

During the past three years the operations have included the following types of enforcement activities:

- Red light enforcement
- 901 (vehicle accidents) enforcement – Intersections where there is a high rate of vehicle accidents.
- Excessive speed enforcement
- Illegal street racing enforcement
- DUI checkpoints
- Saturation operations (targeted and strategic enforcement)
- Court stings

Statistics

The following information shows statistics for years 2006 – 2008.

DUI operations: 994 citations, 40 DUI arrests, 657 tows, 14 other arrests

Red light enforcement: 382 citations, 8 towed vehicles

Excessive speed enforcement: 3,338 citations, 27 arrests, 59 towed vehicles

Illegal street racing: 72 citations, 1 arrest, 9 towed vehicles

901 enforcement: 127 citations, 1 arrest, 1 towed vehicle

Saturation operations: 17 DUI arrests, 105 citations, 9 towed


Court stings: 21 citations, 10 towed vehicles
