**Subject: Claim of Greater Miracle Temple  
City Attorney File No. C35492  
(Department of Public Works – Failed Sewer Main)**

President Fortunato Bas and Members of the City Council:

Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled claim for the sum of One Hundred Two Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Dollars and Seven Cents (\$102,980.07), payable to Greater Miracle Temple (“Claimant”).

Claimant alleges that on March 11, 2022, raw sewage from a City sewer main overflowed through a bathroom and into the main room, storage, closet, stairs and landing areas of the building. Claimant alleges that a blockage of the City’s sewer main caused the overflow and damaged its property.

The City of Oakland has determined that settlement in this amount, without an admission of liability, is in the best interest of the City.

The City Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Thursday, June 6, 2024 (moved by Councilmember Kevin Jenkins and seconded by Councilmember Treva Reid - 7 Ayes, 1 Absent – Councilmember Janani Ramachandran).
