RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CLAIM OF JUDGE GAIL BEREOLA ALLEGING THAT THE CITY VIOLATED THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT BY FAILING TO PROVIDE WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBILITY TO AN EVENT AT THE OAKLAND MUSEUM FOR THE CITY'S PAYMENT OF \$4,950 IN ATTORNEY'S FEES AND CONSTRUCTION OF A PERMANENT DISABILITY ACCESS RAMP AT THE MUSEUM (OAKLAND MUSEUM)

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2006 Judge Gail Bereola ("Claimant") filed a claim alleging that the City violated Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act by failing to provide wheelchair accessibility to an Oakland Museum event; and

WHEREAS, Claimant has agreed to dismiss her claims in exchange for the City's payment of \$4,950 in attorney's fees and construction of a permanent disability access ramp at the Oakland Museum; and

WHEREAS, at its May 30, 2006 meeting, the City Council authorized the City Administrator to execute a construction contract with McGuire and Hester Construction Company for a permanent disability access ramp at the Oakland Museum in an arnount not to exceed Three Hundred Seventeen Thousand One Hundred and Ninety-Nine Dollars (\$317,199) through utilization of an informal competitive bidding process; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the claim of Judge Gail Bereola by constructing a disability access ramp at the Oakland Museum of California by September 30, 2006 barring any unforeseen difficulties; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to extend until November 30, 2006 Judge Bereola's statute of limitations to initiate a lawsuit if necessary to permit completion of the ramp prior to a waiver of claims becoming effective; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of Four Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars and No Cents (\$4,950) be paid to Judge Bereola's attorney, Paul Rein.
