RE: A Report And Proposed Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator To Enter Into an Agreement With the National Insurance Crime Bureau For the Purpose of Accepting A 2002 F150 Ford Pick-Up Truck For Use By The Police Department, At A Lease Price Of One Dollar (\$1.00)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator to enter into an agreement with the National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB) for the purpose of accepting a 2002 F150 Ford pick-up truck for an annual lease price of one dollar. The vehicle will be used exclusively by sworn personnel who staff the Alameda County Regional Auto Theft Task Force (ACRATT).

FISCAL IMPACT

The existing Departmental baseline budget will cover the lease price of \$1.00 and the cost of maintenance, which is estimated at \$7,040 annually (general maintenance and fuel.) The funds will be drawn from General Fund (1010), Special Investigations Internal Organization (101140), City Vehicle Rentals Account (56411), Program (P819).

No additional funding is required.

BACKGROUND

The Alameda County Regional Auto Theft Task Force (ACRATT) is a multi-agency task force whose mission is to reduce the incidence of auto theft in Alameda County through proactive investigative and enforcement efforts, officer training, public education, and theft prevention programs.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The proposed resolution would authorize the City of Oakland to enter into a vehicle lease / donation agreement with the NICB for the purpose of providing ACRATT members with a used 2002 F150 Ford pick-up truck to be used in the performance of vehicle theft investigations.

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Public Safety
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This vehicle has been inspected by the Equipment Division of the Public Works Agency and has been judged to be mechanically sound and serviceable.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The car donation program is an agreement between the insurance companies and the NCIB to furnish vehicles to law enforcement agencies for use in daily law enforcement activities. The vehicle title is processed through NICB to indemnify the insurance company from lawsuits. The vehicle is used by the Department on a 365 day renewable use agreement for the purpose of auto theft and insurance fraud investigations.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: There are no economic opportunities associated with this report.

Environmental: There are no environmental opportunities associated with this report.

Social Equity: By providing additional transportation to members of ACRATT, criminal investigations will be conducted in a timelier manner providing an opportunity to make arrests and reduce criminal activity in the City of Oakland.


DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

There are no ADA or senior citizen access issues contained in this report.


RECOMMENDATION



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NATIONAL INSURANCE CRIME BUREAU FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCEPTING A 2002 F150 FORD PICK-UP TRUCK FOR USE BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AT A LEASE PRICE OF ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00)

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Regional Auto Theft Task Force (ACRATT) is a multi-agency task force whose mission is to reduce the incidence of vehicle theft in Alameda County through proactive investigative and enforcement efforts, officer training, public education and theft prevention programs; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Police Department is a leading participant in the ACRATT; and

WHEREAS, the National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB) wishes to provide a 2002 F150 Ford Pick-Up Truck to be used by members assigned to ACRATT for a lease price of one dollar (\$1.00); and

WHEREAS, the Equipment Division of the Public Works Agency has inspected and approved the vehicle for City use; and

WHEREAS, the Department shall pay for the vehicle lease and annual maintenance out of the General Fund (1010), Organization (101140), and Account (56411), Program (P819); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator to accept a 2002 F150 Ford Pick-Up Truck, VIN No. 1FTRW07L42KE35553 at a lease price of one dollar (\$1.00), from the National Insurance Crime Bureau, and directs the City Administrator to appropriate said vehicle for use by the Police Department ACRATT detail; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the vehicle shall be used by the Police Department for vehicle theft investigation, enforcement, and prevention programs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council thanks the National Insurance Crime Bureau for its generous support of the Alameda County Regional Auto Theft Task Force (ACRATT).
