RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IMMEDIATE ALLOCATION OF \$15,000 FROM COUNCILMEMBER LARRY E. REID'S PRIORITY PROJECT FUNDS TO OAKLAND'S POTTER HOUSE TO ASSIST AT RISK YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES IN THE REUNIFICATION PROCESS BY FACILITATING HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS WHILE PROVIDING SUPPORT THROUGH WORKSHOPS.

WHEREAS, On June 8, 2006 the City Council did amend the 2005-2007 Policy Budget for the City of Oakland to include \$250,000 apiece for each councilmember to use as priority funds for projects at each councilmember's discretion but subject to City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Larry Reid has identified OAKLAND'S POTTER HOUSE assisting at risk youth and their families, as a recipient of \$15,000 of these funds; and

WHEREAS, OAKLAND'S POTTER HOUSE will use these funds to assist at risk youth and their families in the reunification process by facilitating healthy relationships while providing support through various workshops, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That \$15,000 of Councilmember Larry Reid's priority project funds be apportioned to OAKLAND'S POTTER HOUSE at the earliest possible time.
