RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A TWO-YEAR CONTRACT WITH THE UNITY COUNCIL, INC. TO FUND THEIR PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS AT THE FRUITVALE/SAN ANTONIO SENIOR CENTER FOR FISCAL YEARS 2005-2006 AND 2006-2007 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,000

WHEREAS, the City Council has supported the development of a Senior Center at the Fruitvale Transit Village; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Policy Budget for 2005-2007 includes funding to support operation of the Fruitvale/San Antonio Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, The Unity Council, Inc. organization has for the past two years successfully established and operated the Fruitvale/San Antonio Senior Center and thus served the needs of the City's growing Hispanic and Latino senior community; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Department of Human Services is authorized to execute a funding contract with the Unity Council, Inc. in the amount of \$200,000 in budget year 2005-2006 and \$200,000 in budget year 2006-2007 to support the programs and activities of the Fruitvale/San Antonio Senior Center.

RESOLVED: The City Council finds that the performance of this service is in the public interest because of economy or better performance and shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service.
