As part of the Army Base Conveyance actions, on February 19, 2004, California State Senator Don Perata introduced legislation on behalf of the City of Oakland, Redevelopment Agency, Oakland Base Reuse Authority (OBRA) and the Port of Oakland to approve an exchange of public trust lands within the former Oakland Army Base by the California State Lands Commission: Senate Bill 1435 - Oakland Army Base Public Trust Exchange Act. The City's Government Affairs Director has advised that the City, ORA and OBRA each submit a resolution in support of this important bill by mid-April, in order to meet the schedule for presentation to the appropriate legislative committees. Therefore, we respectfully request that this matter be scheduled from Rules directly to the Agency and City Council for consideration at the April 6, 2004 meeting. The OBRA Governing Body will hear the resolution request at its March 22, 2004 meeting and Government Affairs will be requesting a similar support resolution from the Port of Oakland.
